Purpose/ Need

Per a 2017 AE Study Group Report, "Students in Louisiana alternative education settings rarely receive academic, behavioral, social and emotional services needed to address the root cause of their exit from the home school.

Gaps in the services provided often mean that students experience inconsistent transitional procedures upon entry or exit from the alternative school or program."
