

Mandated by SB 207

- No later than December 1, 2023, the center shall provide a statewide: (a) Panic emergency notification system. (b) Anonymous reporting system. The anonymous reporting system shall include a memorandum of understanding that provides for the proper usage of the information reported.
- The system shall allow for the reporting of threats of violence toward any student or other person or any school or facility through a phone application and an internet website. Aggregate data without personally identifiable information shall be provided to the center relative to anonymous reports received through the system.
- No later than April 1, 2024, each city, state, or other local school board shall implement the use of the panic emergency notification system and the anonymous reporting system or other systems of equal or exceeding capability. No later than May 1, 2024, each local school board shall report the systems implemented to the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education and the Center.
