

## **Credit Recovery**

- Local credit recovery plan must be in the Pupil Progression Plan
- Maximum of 2 credits annually and 7 total in high school (overages/rationales must be <u>reported</u> to the LDOE)
- Must have taken an failed a traditional course which is transcripted
- Must be labeled credit recovery on the official transcript
- Courses must be aligned to state standards and have pre and post tests
- Online credit recovery courses must have a certified Louisiana teacher of record or one certified through reciprocity

The full credit recovery policy can be found in Bulletin 741 section 2324.

## **Proficiency Exams**

- Students may earn credit by proficiency exam in courses which they have never been enrolled
- Those exams must be reported per Bulletin 741 policy to the LDOE on a <u>form</u> on the Louisiana Believes website
- The exams may be nationally recognized, locally created, or a portfolio assessment
- The LDOE may recommend changes to exams to meet state standards
