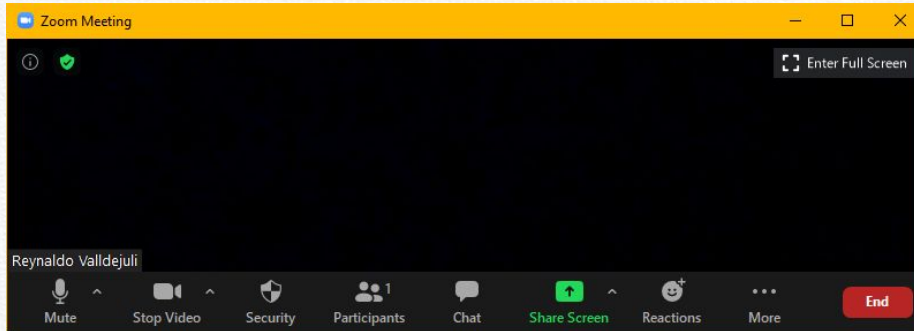

Financial Aid Planning

- The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) opens on October 1.
- Students must complete the 2023-2024 application. Completing it early is imperative to ensure students get the maximum aid available to them.
- Schools/school systems can get live, phone or online assistance with FAFSA completion events from the Department.
- FAFSA completion or having a waiver on file is a requirement for graduation.

Fast Forward New Pathway Timeline

In order to assist schools with scheduling students into Fast Forward pathways, the Department has adjusted the approval timeline.

- November 1, 2022 new pathways must be received by the LDOE
- November 1-28, 2022 LDOE/BoR internal review of pathways
- November 29, 2022 review and approval by the Jump Start 2.0 Review Committee
- January 17, 2023 presented for BESE approval

AP Test Registration and Ordering

AP coordinators can connect to resources to support AP Registration and Ordering process at AP central on the [AP coordinators page](#). Coordinators can download the AP Coordinator's Manual, Part 1, find information regarding key tasks, deadlines, and important updates for 2022-2023.

To register a school to offer AP Exams in May 2023, the AP coordinator must complete the information in the [Setup section of AP Registration and Ordering](#), and then electronically sign and submit the AP Participation form that is generated. The information will provide an overview of the steps the AP Coordinator must take. For more information, please refer to the AP Coordinator's Manual, Part 1.

The U.S. Department of Education has posted a [Notice Inviting Applications](#) for the Project Prevent Grant Program, which will award more than \$6 million to local educational agencies (LEAs) impacted by community violence.

Funds may be used by LEAs to:

- (1) increase student access to mental health services;
- (2) support conflict management programs; and
- (3) implement other community- and school-based strategies to help prevent community violence and to mitigate the impacts of exposure to community violence.
