Cohort Graduation Data Certification

La Data Review will open in April for accountability contacts to:

- Retrieve 2024 cohort graduation rosters and distribute them to schools
- Collect and submit requests for changes to data that will be used in the calculation of the graduation rate and related graduation indices used in the 2024 SPS

The department will continue to conduct exit code reviews for students exited as

transfers out of state (10), transfers to approved nonpublic schools (14) and transfers to BESE-approved home study (16.)

Elimination of Cohort Graduation Lag Year

The 2024 SPS will include data from both the 2024 and 2025 cohort in order to eliminate the lag year for reporting graduation data.

- Beginning with the 2025 graduation cohort, data certification will be divided into two phases:
 - Phase I will continue to be conducted in the spring. This phase will include exit code audits only.
 - Phase II will be conducted in summer, and will include reviews of LEA and site flags, AP, IB and CLEP data, and HiSET attainment.

Requests to update IBCs and DE course codes are no longer reviewed or approved.

Summer Data Certification

In addition to the Phase II 2025 cohort data certification in August, the following data certification will open for accountability contacts:

ACT Index Data: Includes highest score for ACT and WorkKeys with points assigned to students. This is the last time that this roster will be issued. In the future, ACT scores will be on the cohort graduation roster.

DCAI Data: Includes credit counts for students who were in grade 8 in 2023-2024 and points awarded (DCAI is being discontinued after this year

Assessment and Progress Data: All LEAP, LEAP Connect and ELPT data
