Funding for Registered Apprenticeships-Spring

- \$2500 per non-rural, \$3500 for rural enrollments as defined by the United States Census Bureau

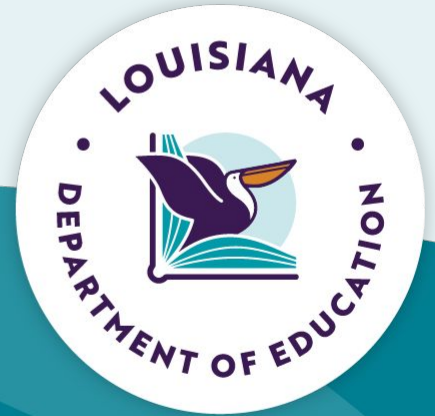
Diplomas and Seals

2025-2026 CDF Mid-Year Report

- The [2025 - 2026 Mid-Year Career Development Fund \(CDF\) Mid-Year Expenditure Report](#) is available for school systems to complete. The deadline to report on 2025-2026 CDF mid-year expenditures is **February 20**. School systems should reference the [2025-2026 Guidelines for Use of CDF Allocation](#) when completing the form.
- CDF funds support increased student access to high-value Career and Technical Education courses and training. CDF funds are 6% of the MFP State and Local Base Cost Per Pupil (\$241) provided for each qualifying student course enrollment in grades 9-12.

This award shows recognition to schools that show a major commitment to serving students and families connected to the United States Armed Forces.

To earn the recognition, schools shall engage in the following activities:

- Designate a staff member to serve as a military liaison and engage in the following:
- Serve as the primary point of contact for military connected students and families
- Work to identify special considerations needed by military-connected students and families
- Develop training to inform teachers and other school personnel of those special considerations
- Create a dedicated page on its website featuring resources for military-connected students and families
- Create a student-led transition program to provide peer support for military-connected students
