2025-2026 Graduate Diploma and Seal Orders

The [Diploma and Seal Order Form](#) is now open to request diplomas and seals for 2026 high school graduates.

The electronic form should be submitted by Friday, February 6.

Only one form should be submitted for each school system. The Department of Education will cover the cost of the initial order and distribution.

Each school system should order 10% over the number of diplomas needed. This overage will take care of misprints, late enrolled students, etc.

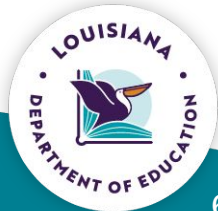

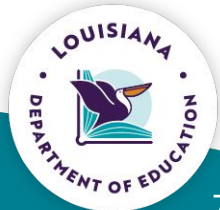


Community Service Diploma Endorsement

Civics Diploma Endorsement

The 2025–2026 school year marks the first time students are eligible to earn the [Freedom Framework Diploma Endorsement](#), a new recognition for high school students who demonstrate excellence in civics education.

The endorsement is awarded to students who score Mastery or above on the LEAP 2025 civics assessment. Recipients will receive an additional seal on their diploma and wear a red, white, and blue honor cord during graduation ceremonies.

- Funding is available at \$1000 per eligible student internship enrollment for the spring semester

- Must have [attestation](#) for 2025-2026 school year on file
- **Eligible enrollments will be funded in the order in which they are submitted**

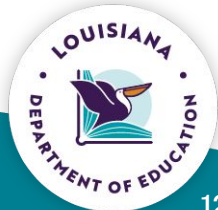

Funding for Registered Apprenticeships-Spring

- Funding is available for approved Registered Apprenticeships in the spring semester
- \$2500 per non-rural, \$3500 for rural enrollments as defined by the United States Census Bureau
- Funding may be used to support all costs associated with providing apprenticeship programming to eligible students
- Must be enrolled in [Course Choice Portal](#) by March 7 (system open until January 30, after that date send enrollment spreadsheets to coursechoice@la.gov)
- **Eligible enrollments will be funded in the order in which they are submitted**

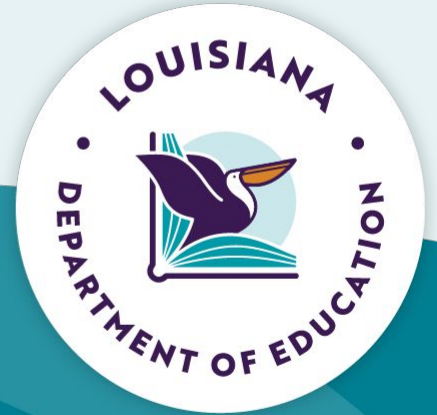
U.S. Presidential Scholars

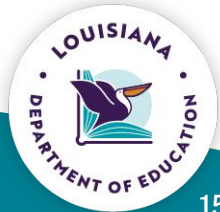

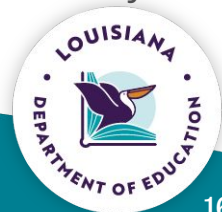

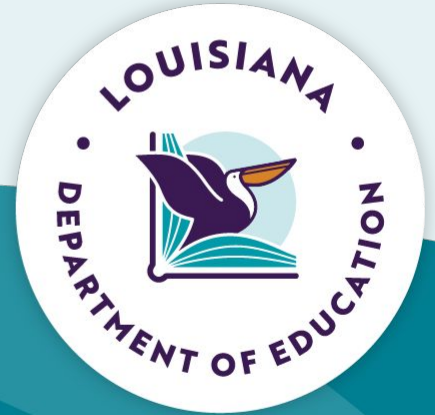

- The [poster](#) provides straightforward guidance on actions that individuals can take in response to active shooter incidents, focusing on the Run, Hide, Fight protocol.

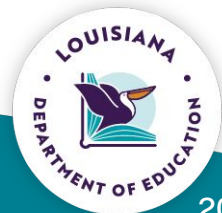

Awards/Recognition



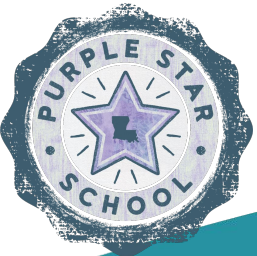
Purple Star School

This award shows recognition to schools that show a major commitment to serving students and families connected to the United States Armed Forces.

To earn the recognition, schools shall engage in the following activities:

- Designate a staff member to serve as a military liaison and engage in the following:
- Serve as the primary point of contact for military connected students and families
- Work to identify special considerations needed by military-connected students and families
- Develop training to inform teachers and other school personnel of those special considerations
- Create a dedicated page on its website featuring resources for military-connected students and families
- Create a student-led transition program to provide peer support for military-connected students

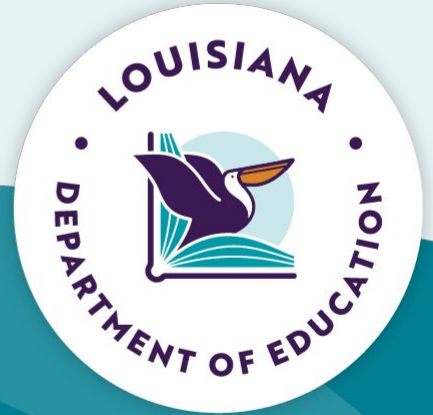
