



Increased Sport Specific IQ


High level athletes have a great understanding of the game. Our program aims to assist youth in developing a higher understand of sport specific knowledge.

Our mission is to develop young leaders who are successful in life. We use experiences and knowledge to educate youth on positive & effective leadership.






The practice of writing can enhance the brain's intake, processing, retaining, and retrieving of information. Through writing, students can increase their comfort with and success in understanding complex material, unfamiliar concepts, and subject-specific vocabulary. When writing is embedded throughout the curriculum, it promotes the brain's attentive focus to classwork and homework, boosts long-term memory, illuminates patterns, gives the brain time for reflection, and when well guided, is a source of conceptual development and stimulus of the brain's highest cognition. (Willis, 2011c, para.3)
