Building High-Performing Teams:

A Collaborative Approach to Attendance Improvement

Principles of Highly Functioning Interdisciplinary Attendance Teams:

Know why they exist

Define appropriate goals and expectations

Establish a flexible decision-making process

Communicate openly and frequently

Handle issues professionally and promptly

Do their individual parts to support the whole

Four Key Concepts:

- Decide what matters
- Collaborate to
- consensus Foster
- relationships Think
- outside of the box

Data is a Bucket with Holes – 10 Questions to Plug Holes

Essential Questions

Why do I need data? What will I do with it?

What story must data tell or change?

Who must know about the outcomes of data?

Where must the data come from or be stored?

When do I need data and how often?

How do I know the data answers my questions?

What actions do I plan to take with data?

How do I monitor change from data?

What interventions can facilitate the change?

How do I report on and sustain the change?

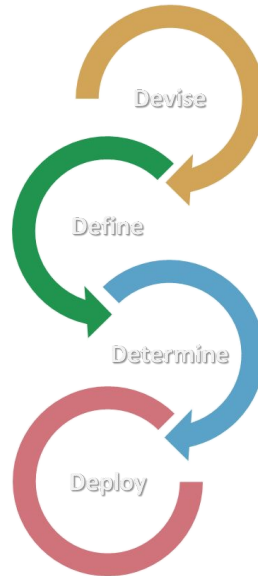
Targeted Interventions for Students with Higher Degree of Absenteeism

A² Excessive Absenteeism addressed by ...

E - Modify Experiences

I - Target Interventions

± - Adjusted for Severity and Intensity of **push and pull factors** of impacted person.



What if scenario:

- If **Absenteeism** is a problem of *experiences*
- **Interventions** must solve *problems*
 - ✓ By those who have decision making *power*
 - ✓ For those who will be *impacted*
 - ✓ Through *any means* (activity, behavior, AI etc.) to disrupt a chain or to create an outcome.

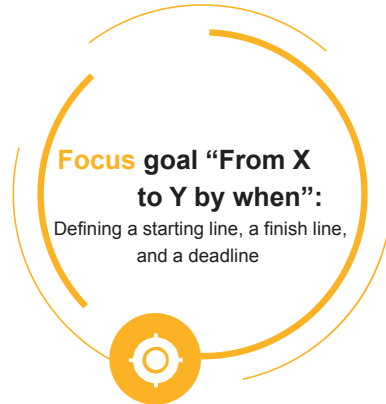

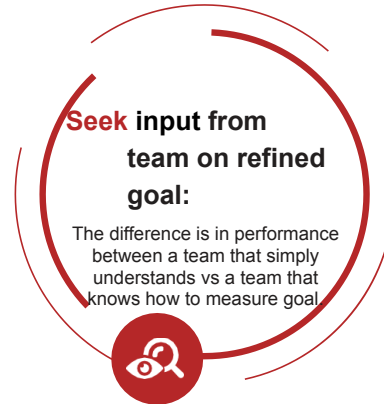

6 Ways

to help your Team Handle Stress during times of change

Manage & Give

- 1 **Manage** own stress first
- 2 **Give** ongoing detailed updates on response to change

Host & Help

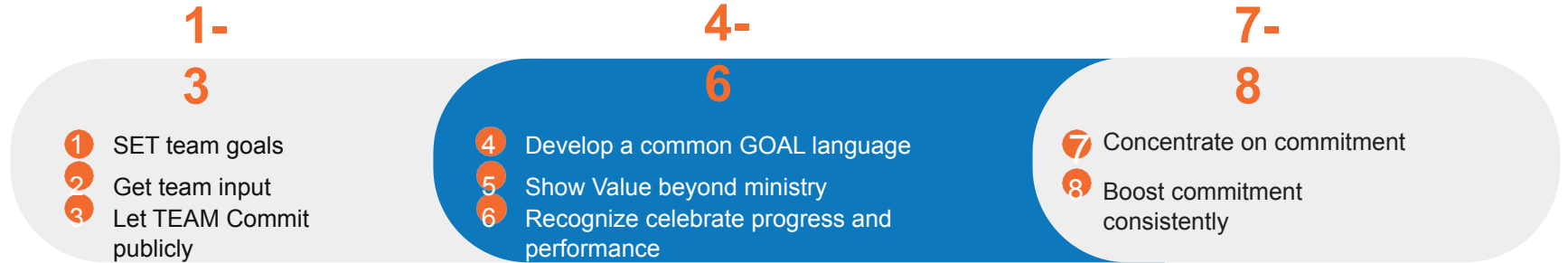
- 3 **Host** team meetings, acknowledge disruption, ask how everyone's doing
- 4 **Help** team narrow work focus on a few key priorities

Offer & Accommodate

- 5 **Offer** hopeful vision for future in 1:1 and skip level meetings
- 6 **Accommodate** needs, be flexible, celebrate victories (even small ones)
