
Targeted Interventions for Students with Higher Degree of Absenteeism

 $m{A^2}$ Excessive Absenteeism addressed by ...

E - Modify Experiences

- Target Interventions

± - Adjusted for Severity and Intensity of *push and pull factors* of impacted person.



What if scenario:

- If Absenteeism is a problem of experiences
- Interventions must solve *problems*
 - ✓ By those who have decision making power
 - ✓ For those who will be impacted
 - Through any means (activity, behavior, AI etc.) to disrupt a chain or to create an outcome.

Manage & Give

- Manage own stress first
- Give ongoing detailed updates on response to change

Host & Help

- 3 Host team meetings, acknowledge disruption, ask how everyone's
- Help team narrow work focus on a few key priorities

Offer & Accommodate

- Offer hopeful vision for future in 1:1 and skip level meetings
- 6 Accommodate needs, be flexible, celebrate victories (even small ones)
