# CSI/TSI Plans

As a reminder, LEAs must develop a Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) or Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) plan based on identification status under Section 1111(d)(1). LEAs are required to submit [CSI/TSI plans](#) in eGMS. The application opened in January and the submission deadline is **May 1**.

## Important Submission Notes

- Plan previously submitted and approved = no action required
- Plan returned for changes = revise and resubmit
- Newly labeled status = submission is now required

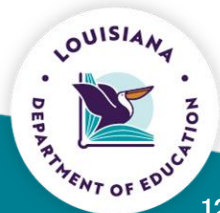
# Title IV Part A Program



# ED Flex State Application

## Louisiana was approved to become an ED Flex State

- Allows the state to create applications to waive certain local requirements for ESEA funding:
  - Title I - allow districts to carryover more than 15% of Title I allocation.
  - Title IV Part A - allows districts to budget Title IV funding in a manner that is not governed by statutory program objectives percentages (no more than 15% for educational technology infrastructure).
- 2027 Title IV Waiver Request - planned release is set for mid-May, with submission due the first week of June.
  - Reviews will be completed in time for LEAs to adjust budgets in August for any approved waivers.



# Title IV Part A Waiver Application

- The Title IV, Part A Waiver **removes federal spending caps** (20% Well-Rounded, 20% Safe/Healthy, 15% Technology) to allow flexible funding.
- LEAs with Title IV, Part A **allocations of \$30,000 or greater** must apply for a waiver to reduce and increase spending in each content area.
- Title IV, Part A Waiver Application will be **released mid-May**.
- A webinar will be held prior to the release to provide an overview of the Title IV, Part A Waiver Application process.
- The Title IV, Part A Waiver Application will be subjected to annual monitoring.

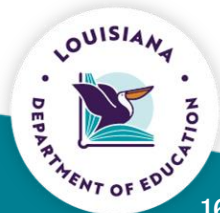

# Equitable Services Updates and Reminders

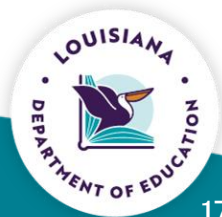
- Be sure you reach out to your new nonpublic schools and document the consultation.
- Have the nonpublic school's administrator complete the Intent to Participate form and schedule a meaningful consultation to discuss the Titles I, II, III and IV equitable services.
- If you have a 21st Century Program in your LEA or community be sure to share the information and benefits with the nonpublic school.
- If needed set a deadline to have the form returned within 1 to 2 weeks after the consultation.
- Always send reminders and document all point of contacts.
- After 3 or more viable attempts you may document and move forward.



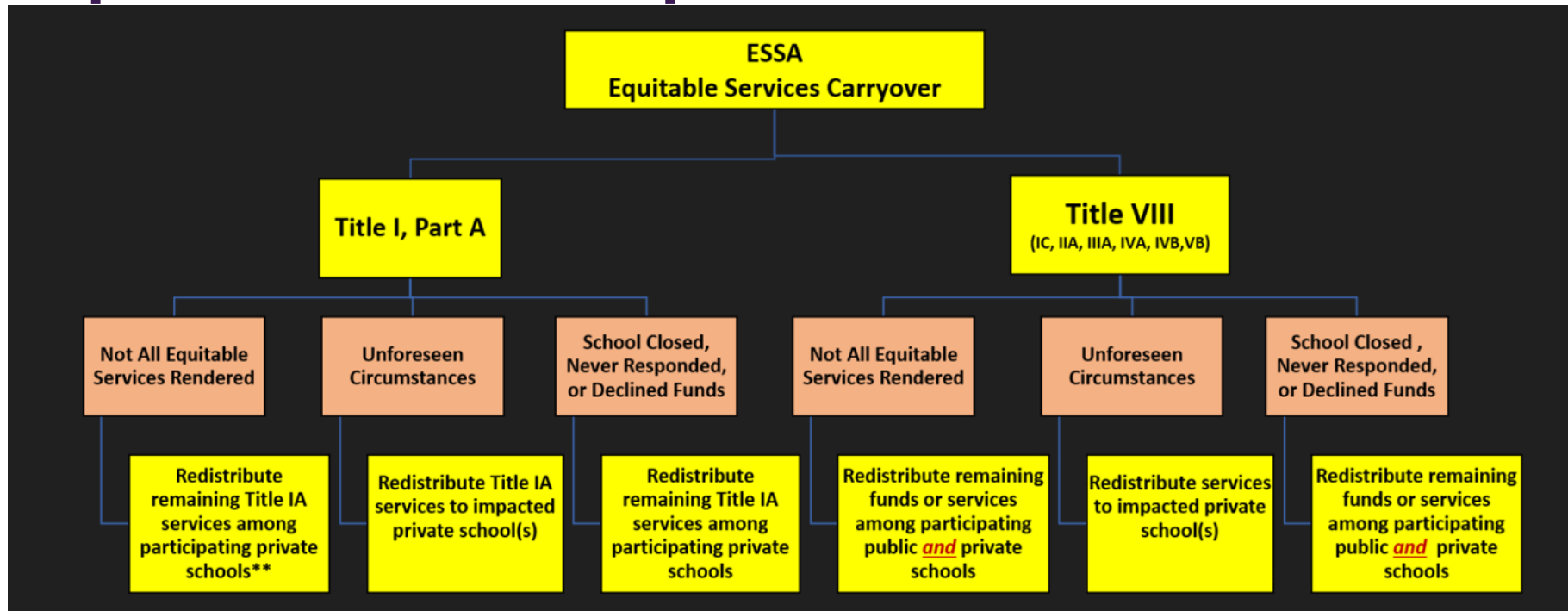

# Equitable Services Updates and Reminders

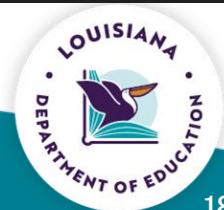
- Rollover/Carryover consultation time is here.
- Remember any nonpublic Title I allocation from 2025 - 2026 is for the LEA to use to design and implement the 2026 - 2027 LEA Title I Nonpublic Program.
- The LEA is always the fiscal and program manager of the Nonpublic Title I Program; not the nonpublic school administrator.
- Though federal guidance requires Titles II and IV allocations to be used in the year they are allocated unforeseen and extenuating circumstances are allowable reasons for carryover.

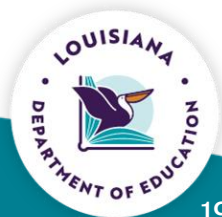
If there was only one nonpublic school receiving services prior to closure or decline of services the funds return to the LEA.



# Equitable Services Updates and Reminders

Carryover Consultation Discussion for End of the Year Unforeseen Equitable Services or Extenuating Circumstances:

- delayed consultation
- turnover in LEA/nonpublic school officials
- Procurement challenges/delay in obligating allocation
- inability to employ qualified personnel/staff challenges
- services cost less than anticipated
- natural disasters
- public/local emergencies



# Equitable Services Updates and Reminders

**B-27. May an LEA carry over unobligated funds despite the statutory requirement regarding obligation of funds?**

If an LEA is providing equitable services as required and meeting the obligation of funds requirement in ESEA section 1117(a)(4)(B), it generally should not have any, and certainly not significant, carryover. The ESEA, however, does not prohibit carryover of funds for equitable services and, in most cases, requires it. **(ESEA section 1117(a)(4)(B)).**



# Equitable Services Updates and Reminders

## Additional carryover consultation tips:

- Have rollover/carryover consultations now and establish timelines to expend the allocations by September 30th.
- Update Needs Assessment if required.
- Unless unforeseen reasons can be documented have the consultation meeting on returning allocations to be redistributed to the participating public and nonpublic schools.
- Contact State Ombudsman regarding any nonpublic school with 2 or more years of remaining or carryover allocations.



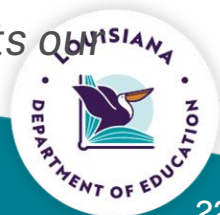
# Equitable Services Updates and Reminders

- **SEA Titles II and IV Allocations**

- All LEAs who have nonpublic schools should have their SEA Titles II and IV applications created and submitted for review, which is located in the 2024 - 2025 funding year.
- Check review status and contact State Ombudsman if you have questions or need clarification.
- The LDOE is strongly encouraging that the allocations are expended by June 30, 2026.
- Keep in mind the SEA Titles II and IV allocation do not follow the 20-month tyding period and therefore can be available for the 2026 - 2027 school year and beyond.

*The goal is to expedite the use the allocations in an allowable manner that benefits our nonpublic schools.*

# High Dosage Tutoring

## 3rd Quarter Fiscal Reporting

- The 3rd Quarter Fiscal Reporting for the High Dosage Tutoring funding is due April 30, 2026
- To complete the fiscal reporting:
  - If the application is in an approved posture, create an Amendment
  - Navigate to the Fiscal Reporting tab in the application
  - Complete the required fields for the 3rd quarter reporting
  - Submit the Amendment for review.

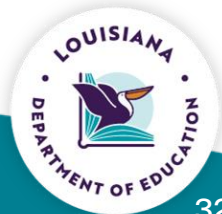
The deadlines noted below have been established by the LDOE to ensure all FY26 funding is used. **Failure to meet these deadlines risks funding availability.** The LDOE cannot guarantee the payment of late claims, invoices, or travel.

<b>June 18</b>	<b>All 8g claims</b> are due in eGMS.
<b>July 6</b>	<b>All Carl Perkins claims</b> are due in eGMS
<b>July 15</b>	<b>All other state and federal awards (excluding 8g or Carl Perkins) ending June 30, 2026,</b> claims are due in eGMS.

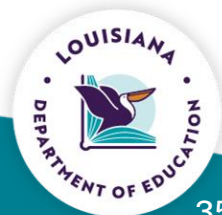
# 2026 High Cost Service Round 1

- All final reviews have been completed for the HCS Round 1 applications and allocations have been loaded
- Recipients need to:
  - Create Amendment 1
  - Budget the awarded amounts by student
    - ensure the budgeted items are aligned with costs that were approved for each student
  - Submit the application for review
- Once Amendment 1 is approved, recipients can begin drawing down funding



# 2026 High Cost Service Round 1

- Round 1 funding is comprised of State General funding and IDEA Federal funding
  - End of Availability:
    - State General funding: June 30, 2026
    - IDEA funding: September 30, 2026
- The eGMS system is designed to drawdown State General funding first
- Note: HCS funding follows the student. If an approved student transfers, you should notify LDOE via the Grant Helpdesk.



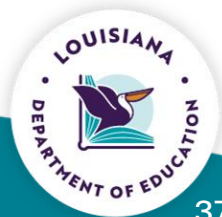

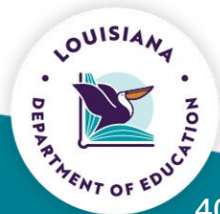
