Super App: One Application for Funding

School systems will submit a single application, a SuperApp, that:

- Identifies the strategies that school systems are adopting aligned to the domains in the framework;
- Identifies the commitment that school systems are making with state, local and federal flow through resources toward these strategies; and
- Identifies the **competitive funding that the school system is requesting** of the LDOE to support these strategies.

Super App Grants

School systems access formula funds and request competitive funding by answering questions in Super App.

Most competitive funding will be reserved to support Comprehensive Intervention Required/Urgent Intervention Required schools, though some sources may support other schools.










Super App: Site Map - Core Academics




