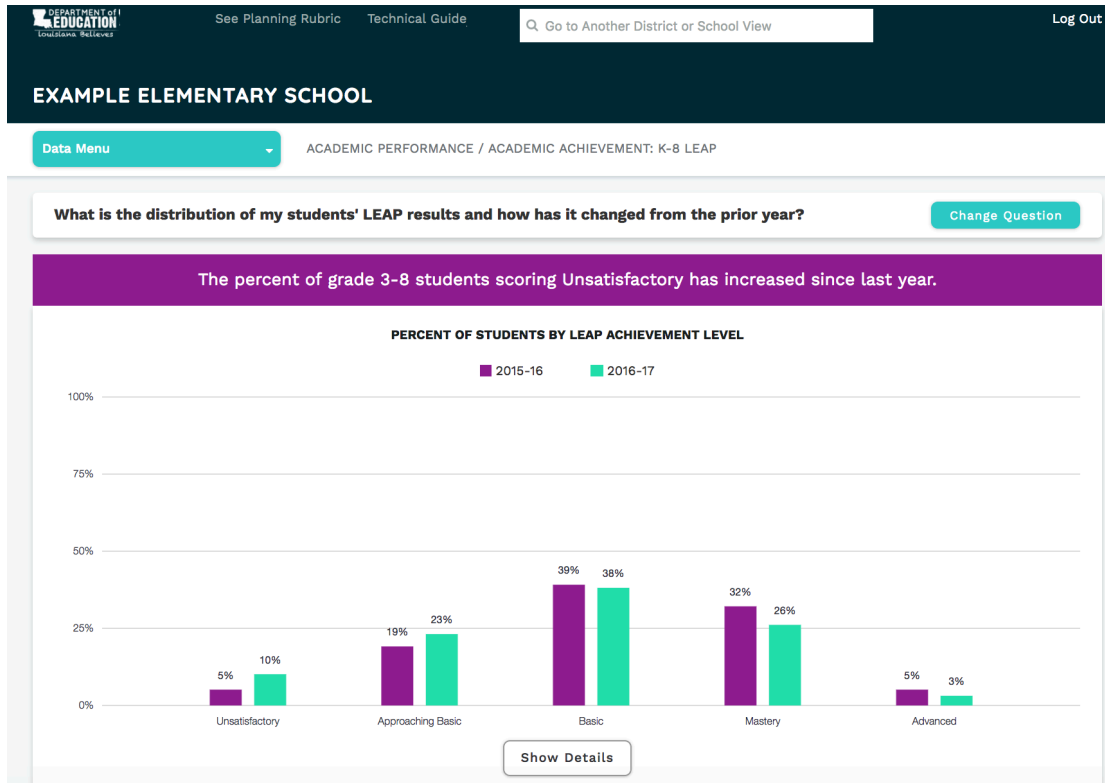
Support for School Redesign Planning: 2017-2018 Planning Guide

The [2018-2019 School System Planning Guide](#) walks school systems through each step of of the [School Redesign application](#), which will double as school systems' plan for their struggling schools.

The School Redesign application asks school systems to:



Analyze Results & Prioritize Needs: Principal & Superintendent Reporting System



The new principal and superintendent reporting system is an interactive data exploration tool that provides school and school system leaders with access to important information about school system, school, teacher, and student performance.

The website replaces the PDF principal and superintendent profiles and is only accessible by secure login.

Website Features

The website includes a number of features to guide users through the data:

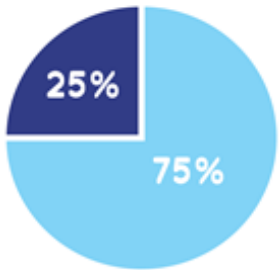
- data across content areas (ECE, K-12, postsecondary, workforce) accessible in a single portal
- key questions to guide navigation, planning, and decision-making
- visualizations and insight statements to help interpret complex data
- exportable charts and data files
- connections to the school redesign rubric to support needs assessments and district planning

2018 Simulations

- In the areas of the portal that display school and district performance scores, you will find estimates of scores under the formula recently adopted in [Bulletin 111](#).
- These are only estimates, and they are subject to change as data are refined. These estimates are based only on 2017 results and do not include any changes that may occur this year.
- Nevertheless, they provide a view of the formula elements not detailed in this way before, including calculations of student progress at specific schools.

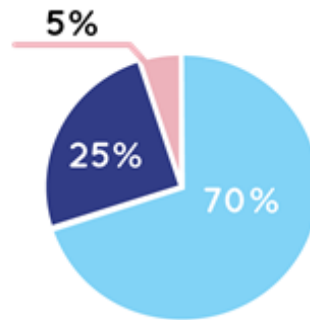

Elementary Schools



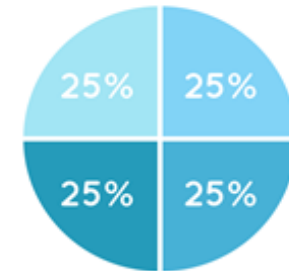
