## **Overview of High Cost Services**

The High Cost Services (HCS) fund was established to support school systems who serve students with disabilities with the most difficult needs.

#### Student eligibility criteria:

- Age 3-21 with an active Individualized Education Plan (IEP).
- The total cost to educate the student must exceed three times the average per pupil expenditure (\$17,688).

 All costs for which the school system requests reimbursement are explicitly stated in the student's IEP.



## **Overview of High Cost Services**

#### The HCS fund includes two rounds:

- Round 1: Students enrolled in previous school year and currently enrolled.
- Round 2: New students who joined your school system from July 1, 2025 to September 30, 2025.

	Enrollment Period	Threshold Eligibility
Round 1	7/1/24-6/30/25 (SY 24-25)	\$53,064 spent in SY 24-25
Round 2	7/1/25-9/30/25 (SY 25-26)	\$53,064 projected in SY 25-26



#### **Allowable Costs**

Details about allowable and unallowable costs can be found in the <u>2025-2026</u> <u>High Cost Services State Plan</u>.

Even if an allowable cost, the materials, services, supports, and personnel **must be documented and clearly described** in the student's IEP in order to be eligible for reimbursement.



## **HCS Procedural Safeguards**

HCS funds are not intended to replace any existing federal, state, or local special education funds.

HCS funds are student specific and <u>cannot</u> be used to support other students.

Specialized equipment purchased with HCS funds will follow the student to any public school system or school within the state.

If the student approved for funds no longer needs the services designated in the application, or if the student withdraws or transfers to another school system or school, the system or school that was allocated funds must notify the LDOE.



## **Application Process**

The application for the HCS fund is included as a competitive application on the Department's electronic Grants Management System (eGMS).

HCS Contact Information and Assurances must be completed to access the application. Once completed, the HCS Round 1 tab will show up in the Competitive section on your GMS Access Select page.

#### **Process Before Submission**

School systems should verify the following information before submitting the application:

- Student IDs are accurate.
- Enrollment in EdLink 360 align with HCS enrollment requirements.
  - Round 1: Enrollment from previous school year with the LEA <u>and</u> current enrollment in the LEA.
  - Round 2: Enrollment between 7/1/25-9/30/25.
- Budget items in the application are clearly documented in the students' IEPs.

#### **Process After Submission**

There are several layers to the review process for the original application:

- **Preliminary Review**
- **Allocation Development**
- **Assigned Allocations**
- **Final Review**

Upon approval of final review, an amendment can be created to submit the budget.



## **HCS Key Takeaways**

- Cost to educate student meets eligibility threshold (\$53,064).
- Student's enrollment data align with HCS enrollment periods.
  - o Round 1: 7/1/24-6/30/25
  - o Round 2: 7/1/25-9/30/25
- Student's State ID is accurate.

## **LEADS Evaluator Training and Resources**

 All first-time LEADS evaluators and designated observers should <u>register</u> to attend evaluator training and pass a certification assessment prior to evaluating.

#### **Alternate Rubric Waiver**

Per <u>Bulletin 130</u>, systems may apply annually to use an alternate rubric for the observation component of evaluation. Approval does not waive additional components of evaluation, including PGP/coaching plans, self-assessments, student learning targets (SLTs), VAM, and principal survey.

#### LES Closeout Reminders for 2024-2025

- Systems should continue finalizing educator evaluations for the 2024-2025 school year. Evaluations (including VAM teachers) may be finalized if all required components are complete.
- Evaluations should be marked incomplete for any employee that did not receive an evaluation. Refer to Bulletin 130 for the conditions that allow an evaluation to be marked incomplete.
- The deadline for entering educator evaluation data will be announced after VAM results are available this fall.



## **LES Updates for 2025-2026**

For the 2025-2026 evaluation period, staff extract data must be uploaded to Edlink 360 before evaluations can begin.

- This includes updated position codes, locations, and assignments.
- After completing uploads, the LES system contact can begin to verify rosters and assign evaluators.

Systems should utilize the <u>LES Technical Guide</u> and the <u>LES Timeline</u> for additional tasks and deadlines.
