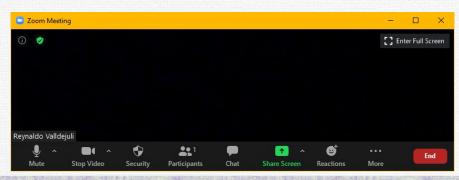

2022 LEAP Results

- 99% LEAP participation rate
- 98% engaged in in-person learning
- 80% of traditional school system LEAs improved
- 3% improvement in ELA and Math Mastery rates (3-8)
- 2% improvement in Science Mastery rates (3-8)
- Improvement in many student groups including economically disadvantaged students, Black students, and student with disabilities



Percent Scoring Mastery and Above



Ready to Achieve! 2022-2023 School System Operations Plan Submission

A school system that receives ARP ESSER funds must make publicly available on its website a **Ready to Achieve! plan** for safe return to in-person instruction and continuity of services. School systems can meet this requirement for 2022-23 by updating their Ready to Achieve 2021 plans to reflect the <u>Ready to Achieve 2022-2023</u> guidance.

School systems must submit a link to their plan to LDOE no later than September 12.

2022-2023 Pandemic EBT

- At this time the Pandemic EBT (P-EBT) program will continue through October 2022.
- Schools are encouraged to have a process for capturing student absences or approved virtual learning specific to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Schools should also clearly communicate all attendance, virtual school policies and documentation that will be required for capturing COVID related absences and learning to parents (i.e. doctor's note or other official notice).

The <u>2021-2022 Career Development Fund (CDF) End-of-Year Expenditure Report</u> is available for school systems to complete. The deadline to report on 2021-2022 CDF expenditures is August 31. School systems should reference the <u>2021-2022 Guidelines</u> for Use of CDF Allocation when completing the form.

CDF funds support increased student access to high-value Career and Technical Education courses and training. CDF funds are 6% of the MFP State and Local Base Cost Per Pupil (\$241) provided for each qualifying student course enrollment in grades 9 through 12. Praxis Core

- On July 14, BESE President Garvey signed a waiver of BESE policy so that teacher preparation providers can enroll and schedule candidates into courses for the fall semester. This eliminates any delay in the impact of Acts <u>707</u> and <u>244</u> of the 2022 Regular Legislative Session on enrolling students into teacher preparation programs.
- This does not waive requirements for initial certification. Additional policy recommendations based on the aforementioned Acts will be brought to BESE for consideration in August.
