International Associate Teacher Recruitment

The 2025-2026 International Associate Teacher (IAT) Program recruitment cycle began on November 1.

Any school or school system interested in recruiting an IAT of French, Mandarin, or Spanish should reference the <u>Louisiana International Associate</u> <u>Teacher Program Guide</u> for more information on recruitment guidelines and timelines.

To request an IAT for the 2025-2026 school year, school systems should complete the 2025-2026 IAT Projected Needs Form by January 15, 2025.

Registration

Louisiana Evaluation System (LES)

LES has replaced the Compass Information System (CIS). LES is live and all 2024-2025 evaluation data should be entered into LES. Even if a system is using a legacy evaluation (COMPASS or approved alternate rubric), data is reported in LES.

LES is a comprehensive data system that holds all evaluation data for an educator including observation scores and student learning targets (SLTs).

LES key features:

- Rosters pre-populate from EdLink.
- Evaluators and evaluatees enter data throughout the year.

Credential Clearance for Educator Certification

- Starting January 1, 2025, Louisiana law (R.S. 17:8.9) requires criminal background checks (CBCs) for certification.
- A CBC will be required before a certificate can be issued, renewed, advanced, or modified.
- Certification processes, forms, and technology are being revised to integrate the CBC requirement.
- Certification applications submitted before January 1, 2025 will be processed without additional CBC requirements.



Certification Process

First	Second	Third	Felony	No Felony
Educator applies for certification using updated application & professional conduct form.	If applicant has never held certification or if LDOE doesn't have a recent CBC on applicant, the educator completes the Credential Clearance (CC) application packet.	LDOE reviews CBC to determine if there are disqualifying convictions.	If felony or R.S. 15:587.1C conviction, LDOE denies certification or censures existing certification record.	If none, the CBC is considered "clear" and certification processing is continued.


High Cost Services (HCS) Fund - Round 2

Oct 1 Class Collection Support Structure

Oct 1 Class collection will snapshot on **Friday, January 10**. The Data System Support team will continue implementing structures to improve data quality and timely submissions. Support structures in place include:

- Email outreach begins 6 weeks prior to the collection closing
 - Emails will identify important data elements with a focus on missing data and/or data that is +/-15% from the previous collection
- Targeted phone calls begin 6 weeks prior to the collection closing
 - System-dedicated Education Information Consultants will connect with data managers by phone to discuss possible red flags and offer in time support
- Superintendent emails sent 4 weeks prior and 2 weeks prior to closing
 - High-level data updates to keep system leaders informed
- Critical support 1:1 meetings available 4 weeks prior to the collection closing
- Accountability outreach sent 1-2 weeks post closing, as needed



High School Assessment Scores

- The LEAP 2025 fall assessment high school window will be open from December 2-20. Scores for all subjects, except Civics, will be released from 4-8 days after administration. Civics scores will not be released until summer 2025.
- Scores for all assessments must be included in final grades for assessment-eligible subjects.
- For 2024-2025 only, the requirement to include the LEAP Civics score in final grades is waived.
