# Attendance Communication Requirement

## Third Unexcused Absence/Tardy Occurrence

Per [Bulletin 741](#) - *Louisiana Handbook for School Administrators*, §1103. *Compulsory Attendance*:

- The principal of a school, or their designee, notifies the parent or legal guardian in writing.
- The principal or designee holds a conference with the student's parent or legal guardian.
- This notification includes information about the parent or legal guardian's legal responsibility to enforce the student's attendance at school and the civil penalties that may be incurred if the student is determined to be habitually absent or habitually tardy.
- The student's parent or legal guardian signs a receipt for the notification. Document attempts (even if unsuccessful with capturing a signature).

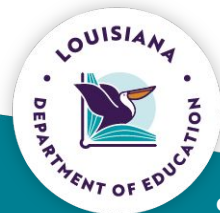

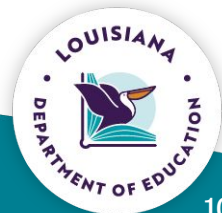

# Dyslexia Core Assessment Program

- [Act 517](#) (2024) established a statewide pathway for identifying and supporting students flagged as “at risk” for dyslexia. LDOE is preparing for the launch of an online application portal, which will allow families to apply for up to \$500 in reimbursement for a dyslexia core assessment conducted by an [approved provider](#).

- Additional guidance and school communication tools will be shared ahead of the program’s January 2026 launch.

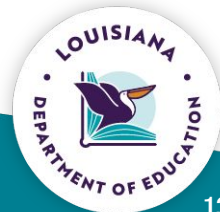

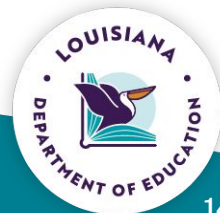


# Community of Practice for Math Leaders

Louisiana students are outpacing last year's Zearn engagement.

- 14.2% more students are reaching 90 minutes per week
- 26.2% more students are on track to reach three grade level lessons per week.

Leaders should:

- Ensure all students are engaging with Zearn weekly;
- Dedicate consistent time for students to use Zearn; and
- Develop routines to monitor Zearn data.

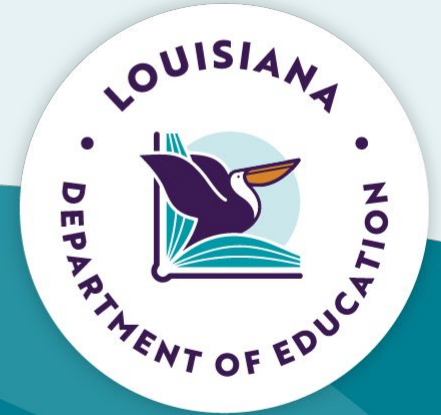

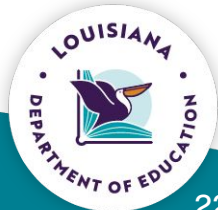


# EdLink 360 Data Collections

- The last day to submit all extracts to the EdLink 360 sFTP for the October 1 CLASS collection is **January 14 by 5 p.m.**
  - This collection of data is used for calculating Value Added Model (VAM), Interest and Opportunities (I&O), budgeted salary reporting, teacher pay raises, and CTE and CDF Funding.
