



#### 4th Grade Reading National Ranking Since 2013









#### **4th Grade Scale Scores**






#### 8th Grade Scale Scores




#### **Growth Among Students with Disabilities**






#### **Students with Disabilities Scale Scores**






### **Growth Among Economically Disadvantaged**






#### **Economically Disadvantaged Scale Scores**

### 2025-2026 Super App

School systems that have met all applicable approval and funding criteria through the 2025-2026 Super App will receive an Approval, Funding, and Implementation (AFI) Summary document via email prior to April BESE.

The purpose of this AFI Summary document is to:

- Share the results of the LDOE's review of the proposed CIR/UIR strategy and requests for competitive funds,
- Identify eligible expenditures for any awarded funds, and
- Identify recommended steps for the implementation of an approved CIR/UIR strategy.

The 2025-2026 Super App allocations are scheduled to go to April BESE. All award amounts included in the AFI document are subject to BESE approval.

### 2024-2025 Annual RFA Application Cycle

The application cycle opened on **February 3** for Type 2 and 4 charter schools slated to begin operations in August of 2026. Applicants must meet the eligibility requirements listed in <u>LA Bulletin 126, §503</u> and must meet each of the listed deadlines to be permitted to move to the next component of the application cycle.

#### Application deadlines are as follows:

- February 10, 2025: Letters of Intent due
- March 10, 2025: Eligibility Determination forms due
- March 31, 2025: Full application submission due
- August 19, 2025: BESE considers applications for new Type 2 and 4 charters
