The purpose of this AFI Summary document is to:

- Share the results of the LDOE's review of the proposed CIR/UIR strategy and requests for competitive funds,
- Identify eligible expenditures for any awarded funds, and
- Identify recommended steps for the implementation of an approved CIR/UIR strategy.

The 2025-2026 Super App allocations are scheduled to go to April BESE. All award amounts included in the AFI document are subject to BESE approval.



Note: Eligibility Determination forms will only be reviewed if a Letter of Intent was received by the due date. Any Eligibility Determination form submitted without adherence to the Letter of Intent due date requirement will not be reviewed.

Early Childhood Allocations

Preliminary 2025-2026 LA 4 and NSECD allocations are scheduled to be voted on during the April 9, 2025 BESE meeting:

- Networks and sites should have received a preliminary notice of award during the week of February 24, 2025.
- An additional notice of BESE approval will be sent after the BESE meeting on April 9, 2025.
- Final amounts will be subject to legislative appropriation.



Early Childhood Allocations

- Final 2024-2025 CCAP B-3 Seat allocations are scheduled to be voted on during the March 12, 2025 BESE meeting:
 - These allocations cover the final CCAP B-3 seat tuition payments for the 2024-2025 academic year, at the applicable rate, for April, May, and June 2025.
- If networks anticipate any final seat allocation balances by June 30, 2025, the following actions should be taken:
