#### **Tutoring During School Day**

#### **Accelerate States Leading Recovery Grant**

- Louisiana is leading the nation with its innovative approach to learning recovery.
- With support from the national nonprofit Accelerate and Louisiana Kids Matter, Louisiana is one of the first states in the U.S. to enhance high-dosage tutoring statewide to help close pandemic learning gaps.
- Louisiana is one of just five states in the country selected to receive a \$1M grant from Accelerate to scale its statewide high-dosage tutoring programs.

Federal funding can be used in various ways to support extra time to learn for students. <u>Act 771</u> requires all students in grades K-5 who failed to achieve mastery on any statewide assessment in reading or math to be eligible for expanded academic support.

Access the <u>2025-2026 Federal Funding Guide</u> to learn how various federal funds can be used, either on their own or together, to meet the specific needs of students and staff.

High-dosage tutoring is an eligible expenditure for multiple federal funding sources including:

- Title I (PD and Tutoring activities))
- Title II (PD Only)
- Title IV (Enrichment activities)
- Title V (PD and Tutoring activities)



## Louisiana Evaluation System (LES)

LES is replacing the Compass Information System (CIS). LES is live, and all 2024-2025 evaluation data can now be entered into LES.

LES is a comprehensive data system that will hold all evaluation components for an educator.

LES key features:

- Rosters pre-populate from EdLink.
- Evaluators and evaluatees will enter data.
- Data will be entered throughout the school year.





#### **Credential Clearance for Educator Certification**

- Starting **January 1, 2025**, Louisiana law (<u>R.S. 17:8.9</u>) requires criminal background checks (CBCs) for **certification**.
- A CBC will be required before a certificate can be issued, renewed, advanced, or modified.
- Certification processes, forms, and technology are being revised to integrate the CBC requirement.
- Certification applications submitted before January 1, 2025 will be processed **without** additional CBC requirements.

#### **Certification Process**

First	Second	Third	Felony	No Felony
Educator applies for certification using updated application & professional conduct form.	If applicant has never held certification or if LDOE doesn't have a recent CBC on applicant, the educator schedules with IdentoGO for fingerprinting.	LDOE reviews CBC to determine if there are disqualifying convictions.	If felony or R.S. 15:587.1C conviction, LDOE denies certification or censures existing certification record.	If none, the CBC is considered "clear" and certification processing is continued.

- School systems are encouraged to have principal supervisors, school leaders, guidance counselors, and those who are involved in the staffing and scheduling process at the school level.

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#### **Annual Dyslexia Reporting**

- School systems are required to annually report the number of students with dyslexia currently enrolled and the number of students newly identified with dyslexia in the prior school year.
- All school systems must submit the <u>dyslexia reporting form</u> by December 15.
- <u>Dyslexia reporting guidance</u> is available in the <u>Students with Disabilities</u> <u>Library</u>.

• Designed for systems in their fourth year of implementation and beyond, focusing on establishing and sustaining professional learning structures that foster continuous growth, collaboration, and improvement.
