School System Planning

The 2026-2027 Super App, <u>Next Level Vision for Success School System Planning & Budgeting Workbook</u>, is now available.

New for 2026-2027

- Louisiana will administer Direct Student Services (DSS) as a competitive grant opportunity to support local innovation aligned with state priorities. This application will be included in Super App for 2026-2027.
- The Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) requires that schools implementing a schoolwide program develop a Title I Schoolwide Plan. This year, LDOE will include a template as an optional planning tool in Super App.
- LEAs will be required to identify ESSA-required comprehensive support and improvement strategies to improve student outcomes. New labeled sites and those that did not submit for 2025-2026 will be required to submit. All others can amend as needed.

2025-2026 Health and PE in Schools Survey

State law requires the LDOE to monitor and evaluate health, recess, physical activity, and employee training in schools, and to provide an annual report to the Louisiana Legislature.

- Please complete the <u>Health and Physical Education in Schools Survey</u> shared in last month's Principal's Newsletter.
- Participation ensures Senate and House Committees receive accurate, high-quality data.
- Deadline for school leaders to complete the survey has been extended to November 10.



2025-2026 Physical Education Standards Review

- BESE approved the <u>2025-2026 Physical</u> <u>Education Standards Review Committee</u> on October 15.
- <u>Committee meetings</u> began on October 29 and will continue through February 2026.
- <u>Feedback</u> regarding the current Louisiana K-12 Physical Education Standards can be submitted until **November 15**.

International Associate Teacher Recruitment

- The 2026-2027 International Associate Teacher (IAT) Program recruitment cycle began on November 1.
- Any school or school system interested in recruiting an IAT of French, Mandarin, or Spanish should reference the Louisiana International Associate Teacher Program Guide for more information on recruitment guidelines and timelines.
- To request an IAT for the 2026-2027 school year, school systems should complete the 2026-2027 IAT Projected Needs Form by January 15. 2026.





Computer Science Technical Assistance Grant (CSTAG)

- All public school and public charter K-12 school systems may apply for up to \$40,000 for computer science teacher training and technology support.
- The <u>application process</u> for the 2026-2027 school year is available through Super App.

October 1 Staff Vacancy Collection

- The October 1 Staff Vacancy Collection snapshot will take place on November 13. School systems are asked to have final vacancy totals entered by 5 p.m. on Wednesday, November 12.
- Accurate vacancy data ensures that funding is properly allocated to school systems reporting vacancies.



Value Added Measure (VAM) Release

- VAM results are now available in the <u>Louisiana Educator Portal</u> for each employee receiving VAM.
- The complete VAM reports will be available to system leaders by November 13.
- The <u>Value-Added Frequently Asked Questions</u> resource can assist systems with VAM related questions.

Praxis Testing Update

On October 1, Educational Testing Services launched Free After Three, a new program that offers eligible Praxis test takers a free retake after three attempts.

To qualify, candidates must:

- Have their first test attempt on or after October 1, 2025.
- Have three or more registrations for the same test title.
- Have reported scores for each of those attempts.
- Be within five years of the date your third attempt scores were reported.

Alternate Assessment Participation Review

- Any school system with more than 1% of students participating in the ELA, math or science alternate assessment should have submitted a participation review request.
- Once submitted, school systems should conduct a self-assessment to confirm eligibility for their students assessed on LEAP Connect.
- The LDOE will provide a justification form to school systems whose participation rate exceeds the 1% threshold by November 12.



LEA Determinations

- The LDOE is required to issue a determination to each school system on its provision of special education and related services under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).
- The federal fiscal year (FFY) 2023 draft LEA determinations are available in the data management file transfer portal (ftp). School systems should review their determination and request clarification by November 21.

Teacher Leader Summit

- Educators interested in presenting at Teacher Leader Summit 2026 can visit the TLS 2026 landing page for submission guidelines and a webinar overview. The application window is now open and closes December 5.

Assessment Development Educator Review Committees

The Office of Assessment, Accountability, and Analytics will convene assessment committees for the LEAP and LEAP Connect assessments in January to:

- Review newly developed LEAP Connect items for alignment and content-related criteria and;
- Review proposed English Language Arts passages to ensure they are content aligned, clearly worded with grade-appropriate language, and appropriate for all Louisiana students.

Numeracy Screening: District Administered Collection Update

All school systems should be following the Interim Guidance for Math Numeracy Screeners to administer their own system-level K-3 numeracy screener for all three windows.

UPDATE: Middle-of-year and end-of-year data from the system-selected screeners will not be required submissions to EdLink 360. Schools are still required to follow the guidance linked above, but will not be required to submit their data to LDOF.

EdLink 360 Data Collections

- Staff vacancies for the 2025-2026 school year must be submitted to EdLink 360 by **November 12**, no later than 5 p.m.
- The Dropout Corrections Module in EdLink 360 will close for modifications to 2024-2025 enrollment records on **December 18**.
- These data are used on the School Performance Profile and reported nationally.

Charter Authorization Updates

Key Dates for the Local Authorizing

- November 7, 2025: Local boards <u>notify</u> LDOE and state legislators of charter applications received within each district
- January 29, 2026: Deadline to consider charter applications
- January 30, 2026: Deadline to notify LDOE of local board recommendations

Note: If the district has not made a decision by January 29, 2026, the applicant is eligible to appeal to BESE.



Charter Authorization Updates

2025-2026 Annual RFA Informational Sessions

The Office of School Choice will host informational sessions for eligible applicants this fall. Informational sessions will be offered twice monthly and are designed for applicants applying as a Type 2 or 4 charter.

Registration is open for the dates listed below.

- November 17 at 10 a.m.
- December 8 or 15 at 10 a.m.
- January 5 or 12 at 10 a.m.



Charter Accountability

- The Website Compliance Review will begin in December. Use the 2025-2026 Website Self-Assessment Tool as a guide to ensure all content required is available on the school's website.
- All outstanding submissions should be submitted before winter break. Refer to the 2025-2026 Reporting Calendar for due dates and descriptions.

CSP Supplemental Funding

The LDOE and the Office of School Choice has secured an additional \$13.5 million in federal funding for charter schools to be applied to Louisiana's priority initiatives. The competitive application will open December 1 in eGMS.

- Applications from charter schools are due by **December 19**. (Type 1, 3, and 4 Charters may receive an early due date from their local authorizer to allow time for adequate submission into eGMS.)

Coordinated Enrollment Planning

November marks the start of the Early Childhood Coordinated Enrollment planning and submission window.

- Community Network Lead Agencies (CNLAs) should begin the process of completing their Coordinated Enrollment Plans for the 2026-2027 academic year.
- Networks should engage all program partners (e.g., providers, community stakeholders, and families) to complete the Coordinated Enrollment Plan in full, so that the LDOE may understand and evaluate the effectiveness of child enrollment practices across Louisiana.
- The 2026-2027 Coordinated Enrollment Plan template will be e-mailed to all CNLAs in early November.
