ESSER III Amended Liquidation Protocols

To afford LEAs the fullest range of flexibility in drawing down the ESSER III funding, the LDOE has implemented amended liquidation protocols given flexibilities provided by ED.

Amended protocols apply to ESSER III funding only and allow additional time to liquidate:

- Goods
- Services
- Construction projects

LEAs have until December 16, 2024, to receive goods and complete services and construction projects for contracts that were in place by September 30.

Statewide Educational Technology Plan, school systems should submit required technology information, ensuring they meet the standards for devices, Internet bandwidth, software applications, and local network capacity to provide a high-quality digital instructional environment.
- The Technology Readiness Tool (TRT) helps LDOE collect information about technology infrastructure across districts and individual schools. TRT data will be used for the school system's digital footprint, which will be published on the LDOE website and will support future technology planning.
- Please see the 2024 TRT Collection Instructions for a step-by-step submission guide and resources.
- Data should be submitted via the 2024 TRT Collection Form and is due by November 1.
