System Leader Regional Collaborations 2024-2025

Overview

LDOE will host regional collaborations with system leaders during 2024-2025. The purpose of these sessions is to facilitate collaboration between LDOE and system level leaders to provide support around continuous improvement and engage in reflection and planning that result in increased academic outcomes. These targeted sessions will address the statewide teaching and learning strategy including designing instructional program coherence for students, building leadership capacity at the school level, and ensuring system coherence.

Participants

System Leader Regional Collaborations are open to superintendents and system level executive leadership including chief academic officers, special education leaders, and principal supervisors.

Pathways	Intended Audience	Description
Instructional Coherence	CAOs, Supervisors of Instruction, PD Directors, SPED Directors	Instructionally focused system leaders will engage in learning to support strong HQIM implementation and strategic scheduling for effective core instruction and MTSS through the structures of ILT and teacher collaboration in alignment with the Louisiana Educator and Leader Rubrics.
Leadership Capacity Building	Principal Supervisors/Evaluators	Principal supervisors will engage in learning to develop best practices for high-quality principal support and coaching cycles that are grounded in the Louisiana Leader Rubric.
System Coherence	Superintendents, Assistant Superintendents	Superintendents and their district ILT members will engage in collaborative learning focused on system-level planning and processes that ensure cohesive messaging and expectations to maximize teaching and learning for all students.
