# **Technology Readiness Data Request**

Under §3921.2. Statewide Educational Technology Plan, school systems must submit required technology information, ensuring they meet the standards for devices, Internet bandwidth, software applications, and local network capacity to provide a high-quality digital instructional environment.

The Technology Readiness Tool (TRT) helps LDOE collect information about technology infrastructure across school systems and individual schools. TRT data will be used for the school system's digital footprint, supporting future technology planning.

The **2025 TRT Collection Form** is due on **November 1.** Please see the **2025 TRT Collection Instructions** for a step-by-step submission guide and resources.

# **ADA Accessibility Standards**

On April 24, 2024, the U.S. Department of Justice finalized a rule under Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act requiring state and local governments including school systems to ensure their websites and mobile apps meet WCAG 2.1 Level AA accessibility standards by April 24, 2026 for larger school systems and April 26, **2027** for smaller school systems based on parish population.

# PLP Key Updates for the 2025-2026 School Year

- Canopy is now the LDOE Professional Learning Platform (PLP).
- Superintendents no longer need to opt-in for auto access to the Louisiana Educator Portal(LEP) and the LDOE Professional Learning Platform (PLP).
- Auto access to LEP and PLP will be granted based on the 2025-2026
   EdLink 360 Staff File (starting August 11th).
- School systems now have two ways to get LDOE PLP Learner access:
  - New: Staff request via EdLink Security (approval required).
  - Auto-access when staff included in the the 2025-2026 EdLink 360 staff file.
- New <u>Data System Support System</u> portal for EdLink Security help tickets.

### **New Applications**

#### **CANS - DCFS Child Abuse and Neglect Clearance System**

Users who are authenticated through Edlink to use the CANS system will have the ability to request and receive results on whether or not individuals are listed on the State Central Registry as perpetrators of certain substantiated abuse or neglect cases that were initiated after 8/1/18. This is in accordance with Act 409 of the 2025 legislative session.

CANS Access: This role is for PK-12 Public and Non-public School Administrative Staff and contains PIL



#### **New Roles**

**EdLink Ops - AFR Business Manager:** This role allows the user to Submit Annual Financial Report for School System or School Site.

- If submitting AFR for the school system, the user should request access through the school system location code.
- If submitting AFR for a school, the user should request access through the local location code.
- Do not request this role through the Central Office local code.


**LEP - Public Certification Admin:** This role is for school system-level HR staff who are designated to sign certification packets.

# **EdLink Security Troubleshooting Guide**

Security Coordinators: Please refer to the EdLink Security Troubleshooting Guide before submitting a LDOE Data System Support ticket on behalf of staff.

Be sure to include the following information in the System Support ticket:

- User's Name
- User's Staff ID
- User's MyLa User ID
- Screenshots of issue if available





### **EdLink Security: LEP and Canopy Access**

All PK-12 Public School Staff must have an **EdLink Security** account to access the Louisiana Education Portal (LEP) and the LDOE Professional **Learning Platform (PLP). New Users** should follow the steps in the **EdLink Security New User Guide** to create their account.

#### **LEP and PLP Access User Requirements:**

- Must have MyLa user credentials.
- Must have a 2026 eScholar record with current MyLa user ID.
- Must be included in the 2025-2026 EdLink 360 staff file extract.



### **EdLink Security Account**

#### Important Account Information:

- Names must match exactly across MyLa, eScholar, and EdLink 360 records.
- Users must sign in to EdLink Security with the same MyLa user ID listed in the eScholar staff record.
- School systems should submit staff's school system email address through eScholar or the EdLink 360 staff file extract.
- Users must sign in to EdLink Security to sync updates to MyLa and eScholar.
- eScholar syncs overnight with EdLink Security allow 24 hours for updates to reflect in user accounts.


# **E-Rate Program Updates**



### **Cybersecurity Pilot Program**

- Cybersecurity Pilot
  - The Form 471 application window for the <u>Cybersecurity Pilot Program</u> opened on March 18 and will close on **September 15**.
  - Total pilot funding is capped at \$200 million for 690 applicants.
- E-Rate Upcoming Dates
  - September 15 Close of the Cybersecurity Pilot Form 471 application window and deadline for filing the Form 484 Part 2.
  - October 29 First Form 486 deadline for FY 2025 for applicants funded in Waves 1-10. The Wave 11 deadline will be October 31 with subsequent Form 486 waved deadlines following weekly.
