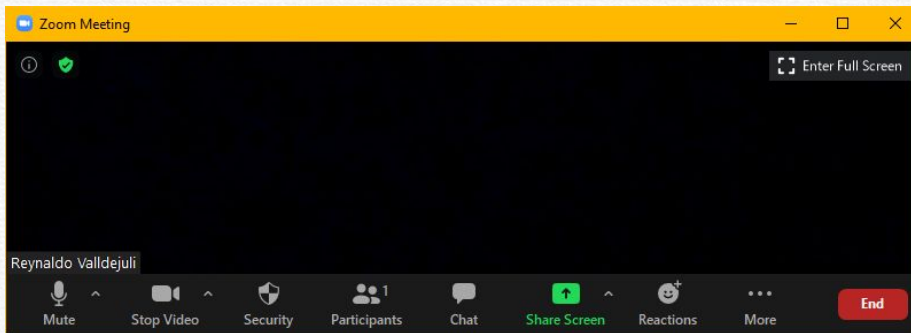

Urgent Intervention Required-Discipline

[Bulletin 111 §907](#)

There are currently 32 schools with a UIR-D ONLY label with 14 on track to exit in 2022. Visit the [School Improvement Library](#) to see the full list.

Out-of-school suspension rate is more than two times the national average for the past three years (Two times the national average equals 5.2% for grades Pre-K-4 and 20.2% for grades 5-12).

Must have an out-of-school suspension rate that is less than twice the national average for two consecutive years to exit UIR-D status. 14 schools are currently **“On Track to Exit”** pending Fall 2022 results (late October/early November).

- Identify/discuss the strategy or strategies that are being utilized in addressing those underlying causes;
