Striving Readers Comprehensive Literacy (SRCL) Program Subgrant Application Guidance

Application Purpose

At the root of *Louisiana Believes* is the belief that an effective teacher is the most critical component of academic success and that teachers are most effective when they have access to a **high-quality**, **Standards-based curriculum**, **ongoing professional development** to use that curriculum effectively and **data from a focused set of Standards-aligned assessments** that measure how well students are meeting the outcomes of the high-quality curriculum.



Louisiana's SRCL project aligns with the state's greater picture of educational reform by addressing three core components: Standards and Curriculum, Professional Development, and Assessment.

Driving Excellence in K-2 Classrooms

Research shows the years before third grade are vital for later school success, and the key skills students develop one year must be built upon and reinforced the next. Louisiana believes that all young children should be ready to master skills and content knowledge aligned to rigorous standards in order to be academically successful in third grade and beyond. Given this importance, **the Department will provide SRCL subgrants** to support implementation of high-quality curriculum, assessments, and professional development up through Grade 5, **with highest priority focused on Kindergarten-Grade 2** improvement and piloting a set of tools that support best practices that will inform future policy for these critical years.

Eligible Applicants

School systems on behalf of schools with the greatest populations of disadvantaged children (high poverty, English Learners, and special education).

Award Information

The State will award subgrants to serve the following age bands:

- Birth to 5-years-old. The state anticipates awarding 40 subgrants up to \$87,875.00 each.
- Kindergarten-Grade 2. The state anticipates awarding 40 subgrants up to \$140,600 each, depending on the
 number of tools piloted in classrooms. Subgrantees will be expected to dedicate approximately 20 percent
 of the funds for pilot services.
- Grades 3-5. The state anticipates awarding 40 subgrants up to \$105,450.00 each.

Applicant Guide

School systems may apply for **one subgrant** in each of the age or grade spans – Birth to Age 5, Kindergarten-Grade 2, and Grades 3-5 – for up to ten schools serving the greatest percent of disadvantaged youth. For more information, see <u>FAQ</u>s.
