Louisiana Department of Health COVID Vaccine Update

Louisiana started receiving very limited doses of Moderna's COVID-19 vaccine and made them available to 107 pharmacies across the state on January 4.

These vaccines are also available only for those in Phase 1B, Tier One:

- People who are 70 years of age and above;
- Home health services patients and staff;
- Ambulatory/outpatient health care personnel;
- Residents, students and staff of schools of allied health; and
- People being treated for end stage renal disease (patients on dialysis).

LDH has <u>published the list of participating pharmacies</u>, along with their locations and contact information, on its website.

Patients must contact a participating pharmacy and make an appointment at the pharmacy. Patients who arrive without an appointment will not be vaccinated. Vaccinations are <u>BY APPOINTMENT ONLY</u>. Do not arrive at a location without an appointment.


In response to the CDC recommendations surrounding shortened quarantines for close contacts, the LDH has updated the following school resources:
