

Request for Applications: School System Support for Students with Autism and Related Disorders

Statement of Purpose:

Louisiana Believes that every child and school should have the opportunity to grow and thrive. To fulfill this promise to all students, including students with disabilities, it is critical that school systems and educators implement a coordinated and coherent vision for specialized supports to meet the specific instructional needs of each student. To be successful, students with autism spectrum disorder and related disabilities require specialized instruction to meet their specific needs in the areas of organization, behavior, and communication. With the increased numbers of students with autism spectrum disorder and related disabilities across the state, effective training and support is needed to build systems that increase the capacity of the staff who serve these students.

Statement of Need:

The Louisiana Department of Education (LDOE) is seeking to partner with an Institute of Higher Education (IHE) with extensive expertise in autism spectrum disorder and related disabilities and a demonstrated ability to support school systems in building capacity of educators to meet the needs of these students. This partner will provide direct professional development and technical assistance to school systems and educators to improve outcomes for this population of students.

As a result of this partnership school systems and educators across Louisiana will have:

- Universal access to tools and resources to help educators build familiarity with the foundational knowledge and skills needed to meet the needs to students with autism spectrum disorders and related disabilities.
- Access to ongoing, differentiated partnerships opportunities that deepen knowledge of content and pedagogy
 of specialized instruction to meet the needs of students with autism spectrum disorder and related disabilities
 in the areas of organization, behavior, and communication.

Scope of Work:

The specific responsibilities of this partnership include the following activities:

- Ensure school systems, administrators, and educators have continuous access to a suite of high-quality, web-based resources to support the individual education needs of students with autism spectrum disorder and related disabilities.
- Develop packages of high-quality professional development, based on professional learning standards, for school systems to support students with autism spectrum disorder and related disabilities.
- Provide direct training sessions to school system leaders and teachers in building systems to support students with autism spectrum disorder and related disabilities.

Eligible Participants:

Any IHE with demonstrated expertise in working with school systems to improve the outcomes for students with Autism and Related Disorders.

Funds Available:

The project will be funded using state-level IDEA funds. It is anticipated that one project will be funded for two years.

Application Requirements:

IHEs interested in becoming a partner in this work should send applications to specialeducation@la.gov by close of business May 3, 2019. The Department will select one organization for this project. The Department will review applications and make final selection by May 10, 2019.
