Curriculum and Instruction (ELA)	Districts will learn how to support teachers in using daily lessons and ongoing assessments to determine student progress toward end-of-year goals. Participants will receive ELA curriculum updates and develop an understanding of why using data based on single standards doesn't tell a useful story about student learning in ELA. Curriculum and Instruction (Benchmark Assessment Pilot)	Districts will learn what steps districts from around the state are taking to complete a thorough audit of their assessment systems and what they plan to do with those findings.
