Curriculum and Instruction (ELA)	Districts will learn how to support teachers in using daily lessons and ongoing assessments to determine student progress toward end-of-year goals. Participants will receive ELA curriculum updates and develop an understanding of why using data based on single standards doesn't tell a useful story about student learning in ELA. <i>Session will run</i> 1 st rotation only	Chief Academic Officers, content specialists/coaches, curriculum and assessment specialists
Curriculum and Instruction (Benchmark Assessment Pilot)	Districts will learn what steps districts from around the state are taking to complete a thorough audit of their assessment systems and what they plan to do with those findings. LDOE will also provide overall guidance, tools, and strategies for all districts to use to analyze and improve their current benchmark assessment system. Session will run 2 nd rotation only	Chief Academic Officers, curriculum and assessment specialists
Data Submission for New Users	 LDE data system staff will walk new users through the data submission and validation process.
