<p>New Form of Industry Engagement</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Workforce Development Boards (WDBs) across the state are forming Education Subcommittees Goal: for industry to establish Jump Start goals for pathways supported and student industry-based credentials (IBCs) earned <i>aligned with regional employment and economic trend data</i> Pilot goals / annual reports in 2017-2018; statewide 2018-2019
<p>New Opportunities for Students with Disabilities</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Regional Mentor Networks are recruiting mentors (in-person and via Nepris) specifically to work with students with disabilities A+PEL is partnering with Nepris to recruit educator-mentors to help students prepare for the world of work (including mentoring students with disabilities) Interested? <p>Summer Jump Start Opportunities</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>Jump Start Summers</i> sessions in full swing. Students earn IBCs, participate in work-based learning, master "soft skills," earn academic credit and receive a summer wage Seeking sustained funding to make summer Jump Start opportunities a standard part of Louisiana public education
<p>Teacher and Counselor Training</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Teacher externships (virtual and in-person) now underway in Central Louisiana and the Capital Region Hope to make virtual externships available statewide Fall initiative to create on-demand, online training / badging for counselors
<p>K - 16 Jump Start Pathways</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Developing Jump Start pathways relevant to university-bound students <i>Pre-Engineering, IT/Coding, Entrepreneurship, Education</i>
<p>Online Work-Based Learning System</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Louisiana is testing the capabilities of an online system - <i>ImBlaze</i> - that will help expand the number and quality of work-based learning opportunities System capabilities include student phone sign-in and assignment submission, as well as automated internship reporting capabilities Pilot implementation planned for Spring 2018
<p>Family Communication Outreach</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pilot high schools linking Jump Start videos and updated Jump Start informational materials to their websites and their social media plans Grants will be available for additional schools to provide more information to parents and families about Jump Start opportunities
<p>CTE Leadership Academy</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Leading CTE leaders across the state are convening to create training resources (in-person and on-demand) for new and current CTE Supervisors Parallel effort to create policy that makes it more possible for districts to recruit and retain top industry talent to serve as CTE leaders
