At this time in the year, we are all laser-focused on making sure that our students are prepared for the end of year exams. Fortunately we do not need to go it alone because the LDOE and PARCC have developed some resources and tools to help us prepare our students for the upcoming PARCC test:

- The **end of unit assessments in the <u>ELA guidebooks</u>** can be an amazing scaffold for preparing students for the PBA tasks. The cold read assessments and culminating writing have given my students a way to demonstrate understanding of the skills they will need on the PBA tasks.
- I was super excited to hear that PARCC released paper-based <u>PBA practice tests for ELA</u> and <u>EOY practice tests for math</u>! Now educators can see what those questions look like in paper format and use them with their students.
- I am also ecstatic to learn that the Department has released <a href="Practice Test Guidance documents">Practice Test Guidance documents</a>, which will help teachers understand how to use, score, and learn from the results of the practice tests. This guidance goes beyond what the Department has released for previous state exams to ensure that educators have full clarity on the details of this year's PARCC assessments.

# **EAGLE Update: New Print Options Available for Teachers**

<u>EAGLE</u> is an online bank of items that you can use to 1) assess whether your students are on track to mastering key skills that will be assessed on the EOC and PARCC exams, and 2) help your students prepare for these exams.

To support teachers and students with limited access to technology, the Department released a system enhancement that provides teachers with a printer friendly version of EAGLE tests. All teachers now have the option to print answer keys and student response sheets from the usual print option. If you

# Presidential Awards for Excellence in Mathematics and Science Teaching

Nominations are now being accepted for the 2015 Presidential Awards for Excellence in Mathematics and Science Teaching (PAEMST). This prestigious award, administered by the National Science Foundation for the White House, identifies outstanding mathematics and science teachers in grades K-12. Mathematics and science teachers in grades 7-12 may apply in 2015. Awardees will receive a \$10,000 award from the National Science Foundation.

District and school administrators are encouraged to nominate one or more outstanding math, science or computer teachers in grades 7-12 with at least five years of experience for this prestigious national teaching award. Nominations must be made <u>online</u> by April 1, 2015. Teachers will be notified electronically of their nomination after their eligibility has been verified. Application packets must be submitted by May 1, 2015.
