

Introduction

The PARCC assessment allows for greater access and tools for all students when compared to previous Louisiana assessments, as defined in the PARCC Accessibility and Accommodations Manual.

- <u>Accessibility features for all students</u> are available to *any* student taking the PARCC assessments. These allow for even more individualized support for students all students.
- Accommodations are aligned to students' IEP, IAP, and LEP plans.

In Louisiana, all students will be taking the paper form of the PARCC assessment in Spring 2015.

The tables below highlight changes in either access or availability as compared to previous state assessments.
