

Kindergarten-Grade 3 Assessments Fact Sheet

Assessment	Who participates in the assessment?	What does the assessment measure?	Who are the results reported to?
Kindergarten Entry Assessment (KEA)	Children entering kindergarten for the first time.	Evaluates the developmental levels of every child entering kindergarten for the first time by gathering information concerning their social-emotional, language and literacy, math, cognitive, and physical development.	Results are reported to the Louisiana Department of Education and shared with families.
K-3 Literacy Screener	Children enrolled in kindergarten through grade 3.	Evaluates a child's performance on important reading skills: Letter Naming Fluency (K, 1) Phonemic Segmentation (K, 1) Nonsense Word Fluency (K, 1, 2, 3) Word Reading Fluency (K, 1, 2, 3) Oral Reading Fluency (1, 2, 3) Maze (Basic Comprehension) (2, 3)	Results are reported to the Louisiana Department of Education and shared with families.
English Language Proficiency Test (ELPT) and ELPT-Connect	Children in grades K-12 who are learning English as a second language.	Measures proficiency in listening, speaking, reading, and writing. The ELPT Connect measures the same four domains but is designed for use with students identified with significant cognitive disabilities.	Results are reported to the Louisiana Department of Education and shared with families.
