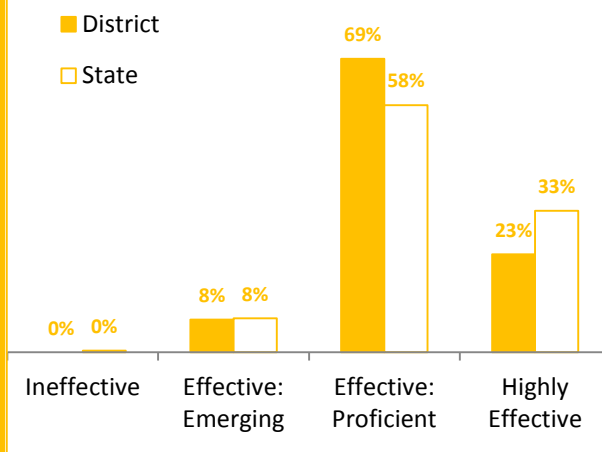

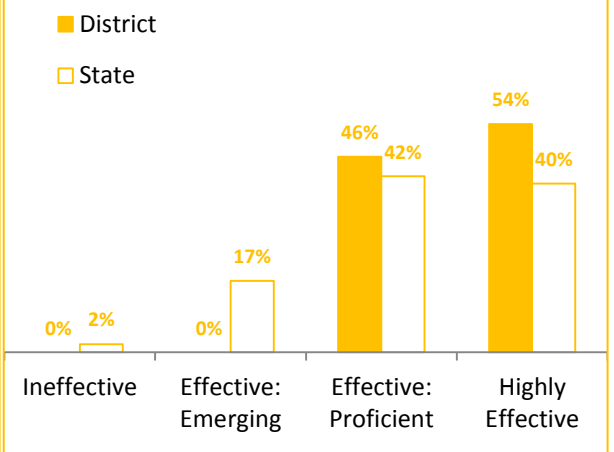
### Final Compass Ratings
