


How to access your school's attendance data:

Chronic Absenteeism Rate

- 1. Go to the <u>School System Attributes</u> page on the LDOE website.
- 2. Scroll down and click on "Student Attendance Data"



3. Under Student Attendance Data, click the second option: "2024-2025 Chronic Absenteeism Rate Overall & by Subgroup." This should download an Excel file.




4. Open the Excel file and go to the "Site" tab at the bottom.



5. Find your school under "Site Name" in column D of the sheet. To do this, you can scroll down until you find your Parish, then your school, or use Ctrl+F (Cmd+F on Mac) to search the document for your school's name.


6. Once you find your school, look at the first row with your school's name to see the overall chronic absenteeism rate. It should say "Overall" in column E, and the chronic absenteeism rate is in column G.





Truancy Rate
