

EdLink 360 Dashboard Overview

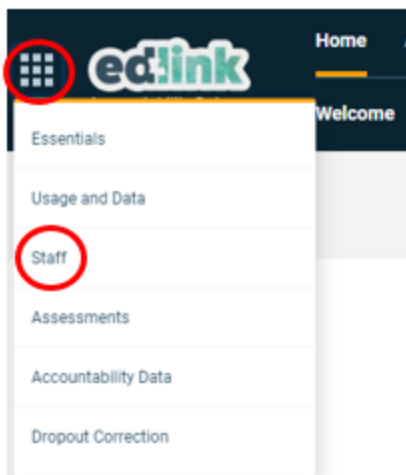
In 2016, the Louisiana Department of Education (LDOE) began publishing state and regional workforce [snapshots](#) in order to support leaders in workforce development. LDOE provides [EdLink 360](#) as a free service to Louisiana public school systems at no cost. EdLink 360 includes numerous data points for district and school leaders to utilize when making data-driven decisions. In May of 2022, the EdLink 360 Workforce Dashboard was released, making data available to system and school leaders in real time.

Purpose

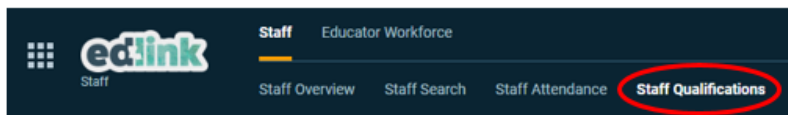
One of the dashboards in EdLink 360 is Staff Qualifications which includes teacher certification information; this dashboard works alongside the Workforce Dashboard to aid recruitment and retention efforts. The Staff Qualifications page contains expiration dates so school and district leaders are able to determine the number of teachers in need of applying for certification renewal, teaching with expired licenses or with a temporary certificate as well as which teachers are certified to teach in various content areas.

Viewing Certificate Data in EdLink 360

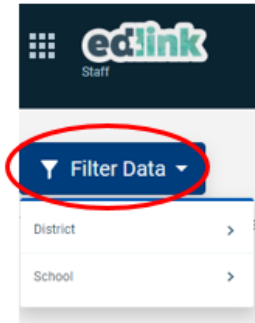
1. Visit reports.edlink.la.gov.
2. Click on the nine-square and select “Staff.”



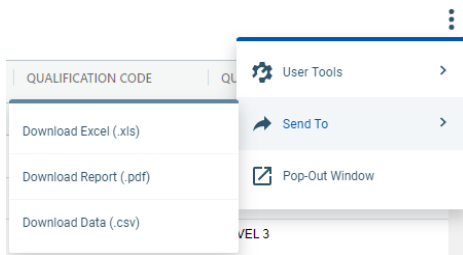
3. Click on “Staff Qualifications.”



4. Select district and school Filters.



5. The Staff Qualifications chart will populate and allow filters by certification type, status, certificate earn date, and certificate expiration date.
6. Download the report by clicking on the three dots and selecting "Send To" with the preferred report type.
