

2025 Louisiana Aspiring Educator Summer Academy Staffing Information

Staff Dates: July 13th - July 18th, 2025 Camp Dates: July 14th - July 18th, 2025 Louisiana State University at Alexandria

The Louisiana Aspiring Educator Summer Academy is a one-of-a-kind, five-day hybrid of a summer camp and a professional learning experience for high school students enrolled in the <u>Louisiana Pre-Educator</u> <u>Pathway</u> or other coursework aimed at attracting and developing future Louisiana educators.

Hosted by the Louisiana Department of Education and staffed by a team of advisors and coaches from around the state, the Aspiring Educator Summer Academy will bring together 100 aspiring educators from around the state for a high-energy, professional leadership experience that propels them on their pathway to becoming highly effective, educators in our state. The Louisiana Aspiring Educator Academy will take place at Louisiana State University at Alexandria on July 14-18, 2025.

The academy staff will be made up of up to 30 exceptional individuals who represent different parts of the Louisiana educator pipeline. Academy staff includes:

- Ten exceptional teachers, professors, and other practicing educators who will serve as **Advisors** throughout the week.
- Twenty collegiate student leaders enrolled in education who will lead and serve as **Coaches** to smaller cohorts of academy participants.

A general day at the academy will give participants an opportunity to engage in workshops led by extraordinary Louisiana educators, to be mentored by exceptional educators at various points in their career, to practice skills related to being an effective education advocate, and to network and build community with other Louisiana aspiring educators.
