

School Support Institutes 2025-2026

The School Support Institutes build the instructional capacity of school-based instructional leadership teams by providing the most current, relevant high-quality professional learning that enables delivery of instructionally coherent learning opportunities to ensure access to grade-level standards for all students. School ILTs will collaborate to plan and implement High Quality Professional Learning (HQPL) structures that focus on leveraging data, student work analysis, instructional observations, and progress monitoring throughout the year. The goal of SSI is to equip leadership teams with the tools and insights to meet their goals, thus sustaining and amplifying instructional growth across their schools.

CIR SCHOOL ATTENDEES

Each Comprehensive Intervention Required (CIR) school will send three members of the Instructional Leadership Team (ILT) to the School Support Institutes. ***Attending ILT representatives must include the principal and two other members whose responsibilities include planning/facilitating ILT meetings, observing and providing feedback to classroom instruction (content leaders, master teacher, instructional facilitators/coordinators), and/or meeting the needs of diverse learners (Special Education and/or English Learner support coordinator).***

System leaders who support CIR schools and/or supervise principals of attending schools should also attend SSI. All attendees should plan to attend all training days.

REGISTRATION

Registration for SSI will be open from May 1, 2025 to July 1, 2025. ***Principals*** should register their own team. A ***system-level/CMO point of contact*** should register system-level/CMO attendees.
