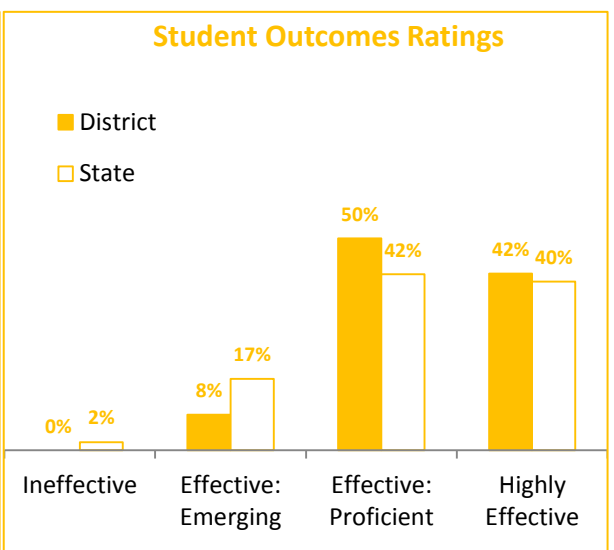
Final Compass Ratings
