E-Rate Support for Schools and Districts

The E-rate program allows districts to receive reimbursements for technology readiness costs including telecommunication hardware, software, and services. This year, the Department is expanding its support of districts throughout the E-rate application process. The Department will host a series of webinars, application support days, and one-on-one support calls for every step within the E-Rate process. Last year, districts in Louisiana received over \$36 million in reimbursements. With this additional support, districts will be able to achieve even greater savings in the coming year.

E-Rate Webinars

These webinars are intended to provide schools with the latest information and changes in the E-Rate program as well as training on specific topics for first-time and experienced applicants. Topics to be covered in each webinar will be released in the LDOE weekly newsletter in advance of the training. Registration is not required.
