Home Page	Tutorial
 Home Page is the first default channel in Teams. The Home Page acts as a landing spot that educators can utilize to highlight important information as well as direct students to learning tasks as soon as they enter their virtual classroom. Class Notebook	Tutorial
 Class Notebook is the second default channel in Teams. Class Notebook is a digital notebook. The teacher can distribute documents digitally through the Class Notebook. Files in the content library are read only. Students can not edit. Files distributed to students are editable. Each student receives their own copy. The teacher can access each student's Class Notebook to monitor progress and view completed work. Classwork	Tutorial
 Classwork is the third default channel in Teams. Classwork is a way to build out modules. The teacher can prepare a module and schedule when students can access materials. Grades	Tutorial
 Grades is the fifth default channel in Teams. The students can view grades from assignments. The teacher can see when a student has viewed an assignment. The teacher can view an assignment that has been turned in. The teacher can grade and return assignments to students. The teacher can also view the history of the assignment, such as when viewed, when edited, and when the assignment was submitted. Reflect	Tutorial

Insights	Tutorial
 Insights is the seventh and final default channel in Teams. Insights gives teachers an at-a-glance data view of students' activity in the Team. Teachers are able to track their students' activity. Insights is designed to keep teachers informed and save time in planning, giving feedback, and providing help when needed. Left-Hand Toolbar	Tutorial
 On the left-hand side of Teams is a toolbar. Activity If an assignment is posted, someone mentions you, etc., there will be a notification alert. Chat Teachers can chat with other teachers in the organization and with students. This is a great collaboration tool. Students can chat with teachers and other students in the organization. Please note: School system IT CAN disabled the student chat feature. Assignments Students can view all of their assignments from all Teams. Calendar The teachers and students can view Calendar to show assignments, scheduled meetings, etc. The three dots (ellipsis) allows teachers to add apps Apps Teachers can add apps.
