<ul> <li>Home Page is the first default channel in Teams.</li> <li>The Home Page serves as a landing spot for educators to highlight important information and direct students to learning tasks as soon as they enter their virtual classroom.</li> <li>When the channel is first clicked, it will automatically set up a Home Page.</li> </ul>	Creating a Home Page  CN  Class Name  Home page Class Notebook Classwork Assignments Grades Reflect Insights
Class Notebook	Tutorial
<ul> <li>Class Notebook is a digital notebook.</li> <li>The teacher can distribute documents digitally through the Class Notebook.</li> <li>Files in the content library are read only. Students can not edit.</li> <li>Files distributed to students are editable. Each student receives their own copy.</li> <li>The teacher can access each student's Class Notebook to monitor progress and view completed work.</li> </ul>	Creating a Class Notebook  CN  Class Name  Home page Class Notebook Classwork Assignments Grades Reflect Insights
Classwork	Tutorial
<ul> <li>Classwork is the third default channel in Teams.</li> <li>Classwork is a way to build out modules.</li> <li>The teacher can prepare a module and schedule when students can access materials.</li> <li>The teacher can prepare assignments and modules in advance.</li> </ul>	Creating Classwork  CN  Class Name  Home page Class Notebook Classwork Assignments Grades Reflect Insights

<ul> <li>Assignments is the fourth default channel in Teams.</li> <li>The teacher can assign work to students.</li> <li>Assignments can be either curriculum-embedded formative or summative assessments.</li> </ul>	Creating an Assignment  CN  Class Name  Home page Class Notebook Classwork Assignments Grades Reflect Insights
Grades	Tutorial
<ul> <li>Grades is the fifth default channel in Teams.</li> <li>Students can view their grades for assignments.</li> <li>The teacher can see when a student has viewed an assignment.</li> <li>The teacher can view an assignment that has been turned in.</li> <li>The teacher can grade and return assignments to students.</li> <li>The teacher can also view the history of the assignment, including when it was viewed, edited, and submitted.</li> </ul>	CIass Name  Home page Class Notebook Classwork Assignments Grades Reflect Insights
Reflect	Tutorial
<ul> <li>Reflect is the sixth default channel in Teams.</li> <li>The teacher can check in with students by sending out reflection questions.</li> <li>Reflection question results are only viewable to the teacher.</li> </ul>	CN Class Name Home page Class Notebook Classwork Assignments Grades Reflect Insights
