I. School Accreditation

Your school's (ATEF) status is one of the following:




To remain fully accredited each ATEF must have:

- At least one Form 200 submitted and approved in the Automated National Registry (ANR) within the last 3 years
- Otherwise, the school will loose Full ATEF status and be considered "Inactive" and classified as a "Non-Accredited Facility"

I. School Accreditation

Becoming an Applicant ATEF


- School sends completed Form 106 and \$50 check to NCCER Accreditation Department
- NCCER will inform LDOE that materials were received
- As Applicant ATEF, school may now begin NCCER instruction



I. School Accreditation

Becoming a Full ATEF

- LDOE will ask instructor to complete Form 105 Self-Evaluation
- Using Form 105, LDOE will perform Accreditation Visit within a year
- When passed, LDOE will inform NCCER and school will receive NCCER ATEF placard



ICTP Process

- ICTP is the Instructor Certification Training Program
 - Purpose is to train professionals in education/instruction
 - ICTP does **<u>NOT</u>** teach Core or any NCCER crafts or skills
- Instructors must receive prior approval from State Sponsor Representative to take ICTP
 - Instructor contacts LDOE, provides documentation of skill and informs state of training location, Master Trainer, date
 - LDOE contacts Master Trainer and informs which crafts instructor can be certified to teach upon ICTP completion

- ICTP must be current for any NCCER Instructor
- Two pathways for certification
 - A. Instructor with NCCER certification (Pathway A)
 - B. Instructor with industry-based work experience or other related Industry-Based Certifications (Pathway B)
- For either pathway, instructors must have prior approval from LDOE State Sponsor Representative to take ICTP and instruct in Core and craft areas
- Not receiving prior approval may result in denial of certification.

Craft Lv. 1 Instructor (i.e., Welding Level 1 Instructor) **Craft Lv. 2 Instructor** (i.e., Welding Level 2 Instructor)

- Instructor has an LDOE Teaching Certificate (may be in any content area)
- Instructor must contact State Sponsor Representative (LDOE) for approval <u>prior to</u> <u>ICTP</u>.

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II. Accrediting Instructors Pathway B

Resume and documentation demonstrating ability or skill in Core

Resume and documentation demonstrates ability or skill in craft

Instructor Certification Training Program (ICTP) Completed *NCCER REQUIREMENT* LDOE Prior Approval to take ICTP REQUIRED

Core Instructor

Craft Lv. 1 Instructor

- Instructor submits resume and documentation to State Sponsor Representative (LDOE)
- Panel (made up of industry, trade school, and post-secondary) reviews resume/documentation
- After approval, instructor may take ICTP and will be certified to teach Core and/or Level 1
 of a craft

Louisiana Believes

- Resume and documentation submitted to LDOE demonstrating skill or ability in welding
- Resume and documentation verified and approval of level certifications given by review panel



Louisiana Believes

Adding Crafts to Active Instructors

- For instructors with current ICTP, craft instructor certifications can be added in the following ways:
 - Attain NCCER craft level certification at Super Summer Institute
 - Attain NCCER craft level certification through an ATEF or Accredited Training Sponsor (ATS)
 - ABC
 - LCTCS
 - Other third party ATSs
 - High School ATEFs under LDOE

Adding Instructor Crafts through High School ATEF

- School must already have ATEF status
- Instructor teaching craft provides LDOE State Sponsor Representative the following:
 - Course to be taught
 - Date(s) of course
 - Instructor's NCCER Card Number
 - Instructor will maintain all paperwork as required by NCCER
- When ANR transcripts are updated, participants notify LDOE State Sponsor Representative of completion and will have their profiles updated

III. Resources

LDOE Guidelines

- NCCER requires that guidelines be provided to each ATEF.
- The LDOE Guidelines were formed from NCCER Guidelines. Information not applicable to the high school setting was removed.
- Guidelines are a framework that all ATEF Representatives must follow.
