### AP® Exam Fee Reimbursement Application Process – Low Income

Through the AP® Exam Fee Reimbursement Program, the Department will reimburse \$53 for each AP® exam taken by students enrolled in both public and BESE-approved nonpublic schools who meet the *low-income* eligibility criteria resulting in \$0 cost to qualifying students.

### AP® Exam Fee Reimbursement Application Process – Low Income

The term "low-income individual" refers to an individual who is determined by a State Educational Agency\* or Local Educational Agency to be a child, ages 5 - 19, from a low-income family, on the basis of data used to determine allocations such as:

- Data on children for free or reduced price meals under the National School Lunch
   Act
- Data on children in families that receive assistance under Part A of Title IV of the Social Security Act
- Data on children eligible to receive medical assistance under the Medicaid Program under Title XIX of the Social Security Act
- Through an alternate method that combines or extrapolates from those data

\*CEP Schools will use information corresponding with direct certified students only. Non-CEP schools will use the same as previous years — direct certified and lunch forms.

### AP® Exam Fee Reimbursement Application Process – New Courses

• In addition, the Department will reimburse the full \$92 for each new\* AP® Exam taken by students enrolled in a public school which is implementing or expanding an AP program.

\*The term "new  $AP^{\mathbb{R}}$  course offering" refers to an  $AP^{\mathbb{R}}$  course that has been implemented in 2015-16 in addition to  $AP^{\mathbb{R}}$  courses previously offered at the same educational institution.

• All fee reimbursements, for both low-income and new course exams, are for students who were enrolled in a rigorous course in preparation for the AP® exam taken during the May 2016 testing cycle and were between the ages of 5 and 19 on exam day. Funds are limited and will be available until completely allocated.

#### AP® Dates to Remember

Date	Reminder
February 26	AP exam fee reimbursement application deadline
March 25	Priority deadline for schools to order AP exams
March 30	Deadline for ordering pre-administration materials
April 8	Extension deadline for schools to order AP exams. Each order received after this date will incur a \$55 late fee.
April 15	Final deadline for schools to order AP exams. No orders will be accepted after this date.
May 2 – 13	AP exam administration window
June 1	Deadline to submit all exam materials to the College Board's AP Services division.
June 15	Postmark deadline for all AP exam fee payments. Late payments incur a \$225 fee.
July	AP score reports are available to designated colleges, students, high schools, and LEAs. Teachers of authorized AP courses and school administrators can access AP Instructional Planning Reports.

#### Sample GEPA Statements

#### Sample 1:

High has promoted AP classes through the registration process, morning announcements, and academic classes. The school is also considering adding a locally-initiated elective that would essentially make AP courses a full-year course. For example, the fall course for ENGLISH III would be considered an ENGLISH ELECTIVE and the spring course would become ENGLISH III AP. This adjustment could increase student participation and success by allowing adequate pacing for course content.

#### Sample 2:

High School recruits students who have not previously enrolled in honors and advanced classes in middle school to enter honors classes in 9<sup>th</sup> grade. This invitation is based on students' LEAP scores. Students attend classes with traditional honors enrolled students. This has provided the opportunity for a greater number of students from our underserved populations to receive preparation in prerequisite courses building to the advanced AP courses. Enrollment in the AP courses has continued to increase. We also follow all district policies to reduce barriers identified in GEPA.

# IB® New Course Exam Fee Reimbursement Application Process

- LDOE will reimburse \$110 for each **new** International Baccalaureate<sup>®</sup> Exam taken by students enrolled in a Louisiana public school that is implementing or expanding an IB<sup>®</sup> program.
- The IB fee reimbursements are for students who were enrolled in an authorized **new\*** IB<sup>®</sup> course offering in preparation for an IB<sup>®</sup> exam taken during the 2016 testing cycle and were between the ages of 5 and 19 on exam day. **Funds are limited and will be available until they are completely allocated**.

<sup>\*</sup>The term "new IB® course offering" refers to an IB® course that has been implemented in addition to IB® courses previously offered at the same educational institution.


